## 2010-2011 Volunteer Opportunities

*Please check your areas of interest, so that we may contact you.*

- Junior Patrons:** Volunteers introduce children (ages 3-13) to Houston Ballet through special matinee performances of *The Nutcracker* and other child-friendly ballets. Such performances are followed by a Green Room party and a backstage tour. Volunteers assist at Green Room parties and backstage. There are usually 4-6 Junior Patron events in the course of the year.
  
- Nutcracker Market Volunteers:** This four-day shopping extravaganza held in November at Reliant Center boasts more than 300 merchants, and encompasses special social and fundraising events. Events include a preview party, an opening-day luncheon and fashion show, and a Friday brunch and fashion show. Volunteers are essential to the Market's success. Shifts are approximately three hours and include free admission, beverages, and snacks.
  
- Student Matinee:** Houston Ballet offers schools the opportunity to attend a matinee performance at a discounted rate. Participating schools receive a set of performance programs specifically designed for elementary and middle school students. Volunteers are needed to help usher students to and from their buses. The performances last for approximately two hours, making the total time commitment 4 to 4.5 hours total. Breakfast is provided and all volunteers are invited to watch the performance if seating is available.
  
- Studio Series:** During one week in the autumn and one week in the spring HBII dancers perform selections from both classical and contemporary ballets. Volunteers are needed to usher school students into Studio A for the demonstration-performances.
  
- Theater District Open House:** In late summer volunteers welcome the public to Wortham Center and provide information about Houston Ballet performances, membership and activities.
  
- Wortham Boutique:** Throughout the Ballet's dance season volunteers staff the booth at Wortham Theater where ballet-related items are sold
