# WE ARE HOUSTON BALLET

*Mission Statement:* To inspire a lasting love and appreciation for dance through artistic excellence, exhilarating performances, innovative choreography, and superb educational programs.

Founded in 1955, Houston Ballet has grown into one of the country's largest and most respected ballet companies. Under the artistic leadership of acclaimed Australian Choreographer Stanton Welch AM and former American Ballet Theatre principal dancer Julie Kent, the company, comprised of 61 dancers representing 15 countries and 18 states, is considered a leader in the field, nurturing the creation of new full-length narrative ballets while commissioning contemporary works from both prominent and emerging choreographers. Houston Ballet's Margaret Alkek Williams Center for Dance houses the professional company along with the acclaimed Houston Ballet Academy, while Education and Community Engagement programs keep the organization connected to local neighborhoods and schools. Houston Ballet engages a global audience through tours to international festivals and leading venues around the world, including theaters in Dubai, Spain, Japan, and Moscow. Annually, Houston Ballet engages over 350,000 individuals throughout the city of Houston and the world.


